PHA BOARD APPROVES PROJECT

The officers and board of the Pintlala Historical Association met on March 16th and voted to fund the placement of an historical marker designating the site of the Pintlala Grange Hall.

The text for the marker has been approved by the Historical Marker Committee of the Alabama Historical Association. The text features the Grange Association on one side and the Grange Hall School on the other. The cost for the marker, which includes a mounting post and shipping, is \$1,485.00. The PHA board voted to use funds from the Marker Fund to expedite this project.

We hope that those who are interested in perpetuating the existence and history of the Grange Hall might take this opportunity to contribute to the Marker Fund. This will avoid depleting this fund. What an ideal way to give memorials or honoraria for loved and admired ones. The PHA welcomes any and all donations. Why a marker for the Grange? After Mary Ann Neeley's presentation at the last PHA meeting, several of our members realized that many people had no clue as to what the Grange was or where it had been located in Pintlala. Future generations certainly would not have this knowledge. There is, however, grange information on file at the Pintlala Library. For these reasons, it was felt that a marker was needed to recognize the Grange and its place in the history of the Pintlala community.

In 1978, the building was in a dilapidated condition and abandoned. At the initiation of the Landmarks Foundation, the Montgomery County Board of Education, as owners of the building, donated it to Landmarks to be used at Old Alabama Town. Mr. Ed Lowder of the Alabama Farm Bureau gave \$20,000 to aid with the moving and restoration of the Grange building which had played such an important role in the agricultural heritage of our state.

We are fortunate that the Grange Hall building has been restored and is a vital part of Old Alabama Town. We encourage those interested in the Grange to visit it in Montgomery. We hope all PHA members and other interested persons will aid us in this worthy project.

TEXT of Marker as Follows:

Side 1

Pintlala Grange Hall

The National Grange of the Patrons of Husbandry was organized in 1867 to provide economic, social and cultural improvements for farmers and their families. Pintlala's Grange Hall was erected circa 1875 on land adjacent to this marker. By the 1890s the popularity of the Grange began to wane. On July 21 - 23, 1891, the last meeting of the Alabama Granges took place in Pintlala. The Federal Land Bank was organized as the National Farm Loan Association of Pintlala on August 17, 1917. Grange Hall was the site of their regular meetings.

Grange Hall School

From circa 1880 to 1922 school was held in one room of Grange Hall for seven months a year. Pintlala School was built and opened in 1923 and the Board of Education purchased the Grange property. The building was used for home economics classes and, from 1931 to 1952, served as home for Pintlala School caretakers. Over the years it was site of community dances, a meeting place for Boy and Girl Scouts, and the Pintlala Baptist Church (1960). Vacant and deteriorating, the building was given to Landmarks Foundation and moved in 1978 to Old Alabama Town, Montgomery, Alabama.

Mt. Carmel Cemetery

At Mt. Carmel United Methodist Church
Hickory Grove Rd. Montgomery, County, AL.

Mt. Carmel is a very interesting study in demographics and family relationships. Most of the families interred at Mt. Carmel Cemetery are related to each other in some way through the families who settled the area in the early part of the 19th century. Some of these families migrated together from Georgia and/or the Carolinas. Quite a few of these families can trace their lineage back to the Mayflower passenger Edward Doty through the ancestry of Levinia Brack Anderson and her children.

Mt. Carmel Cemetery was inventoried by Lurline Hall and Laurie Sanders June 4, 1992 and updated by Lurline in 2000 and 2002. This alphabetized list with relationships was prepared by Mamie M Sellers during the year 2000 with additions in 2002. The relationships shown are derived from data compiled by many individuals both from personal recollections and documented sources. Not all those who may have contributed to this data base are known to the compiler but included are: Lurlene Hall, Vera Sellers Kraus, Catherine Sellers, Mildred Shirley, Zelma Guy Davis, Corrine Guy Scaife, and Mamie Sellers.
