In lieu of a program, we will adjourn following the business meeting and assemble at the MTIS cemetery, recently moved from Kilby, for a very brief memorial service. Please dress comfortably for the occassion and bring a lawn chair if you wish. The cemetery is adjacent to Tabernacle Road near the Tabernacle Methodist Church in Pintlala.

\*\*\*\* Robert S. Moseley, his half brother, Edward, their vives, children and some brothers and sisters came to Alabama around 1820 from Morgan County, Georgia, near Milledgeville. They probably followed the old Federal Road. Robert and his family settled at what was later the Kilby reservation where he had a grant of 740 acres. Edward and his family came on to Pintlala. The six graves identifiable at Kilby were:

Edward (d.1834) and his wife Martha Butler (d.1831) are burged in the cemetery in unmarked graves. The half brothers are remarked here at the MTLS cemetery. Also buried at the cemetery is Nancy Allen, wife of W.P. Allen. She was born 10/18/1838 and died 10/15/1885. Any additional information on her would be appreciated.
